### **Safety considerations applicable to all cricket activities during the 2020–21 indoor season**

All participants must follow instructions of the venue they're visiting and comply with general restrictions on maximum participation and other mandatory safety measures imposed by the national and local health authorities.

#### General instructions

- Arrive dressed in your playing / training kit; do not use the dressing rooms
- Observe good hygiene; wash and/or disinfect your hands and don't touch your face
- Use a face mask when you're not actively training or playing
- Keep your distance during the activities whenever possible
- Install the Koronavilkku application on your mobile phone and keep the tracing on when participating in cricket

If you have any relevant symptoms or suspect you may have been exposed to the virus

- Do not participate in training or matches
- Self-isolate at home
- Fill in the questionnaire at <https://www.omaolo.fi> (FI,SE,EN); remember to state in additional information your sport, club, and team
- Contact your local health authority to get tested as soon as possible
- Contact your club

#### Instructions for the 2020–21 Indoor League

- Due to the restrictions, only players, match officials, and CF officials are permitted to attend the matches (if the restrictions are relaxed or lifted, others can attend, too)
- Avoid dressing rooms, use face masks when off the field, avoid close contact on the field, keep your distance off the field, don't use saliva with the ball, don't share equipment, bring your own disinfectant and wipes
- If an exposure is discovered in the venue on a match day, all participants should schedule a test as soon as possible
- If you suspect or know that you have played after you've contracted the virus, please contact the CF Technical Director at +358 40 768 4258 for a confidential debriefing (your name will not be made public and the information will be used for tracing purposes only)
- If a player plays after they've been diagnosed with COVID-19 and before they've been cleared by a physician to participate, they will be penalised with a suspension ranging from one year to life
- The LSC Chair will determine whether forfeits and instances of a side playing short are due to reasonable pandemic safety precautions, in which case the LSC Chair may choose to forego penalties for forfeiting or playing short

**Do NOT participate in any cricket if you have symptoms  
that may indicate a coronavirus infection.**
